Art Deco was one of the major influencing design motifs of the 20th century. Recognizable for its heavy use of metalwork and geometric lines, the style streamlined design in the 1920's to the 1940's. The iconic forms of clean ornamentation, angular designs and metallic finishes have carried themselves into the 21st century.

The Art Deco movement has seen resurgence in modern design, where the bold geometry stands out among the clean simplicity of modernist design.
