INFRA-STRUCTURE Van Dusen-Designed System for Flos

Flos, the iconic manufacturer of high-end designer fixtures has created a unique news system designed by Belgium-based architect and designer Vincent Van Dusen, to be released late 2016/early 2017. The Infra - Structure system pulls inspiration from the early 20th century Bauhaus movement to create an industrial system that puts form over function and provides a simple, adaptable and clean lighting. Using exclusive magnetic technology developed by Flos and 24v track power, Infra – Structure allows for endless lighting solutions that can be rearranged and personalized for each space it is in. The system is built out of a tubular track with graphite conductor

and magnetic instillation and is suspended by a rod available in various heights to fit the ceiling height of the space. The Infra – Structure integrates with both new and existing Flos fixtures, including the round lamp, spot 50/90/120, and light tube.

Flos publicly launched the new design at their showroom during Milan Design Week 2016 as part of a collection of new fixtures designed by Van Dusen for Flos. **The System will be available in US markets at the end of 2016 or the beginning of 2017.**
